<b>Training manuals</b>	OFTEC technical books 1 and 3 will be required. OFTEC rules require that candidate's must use an up to date set of their manuals during the training course (ask us for pricing).
<b>Competence</b>	The candidate's knowledge and understanding of the subject will be established by the application of a multi-choice theoretical question papers and completion of specified practical tasks.
<b>Assessment</b>	The assessment will be conducted by an assessor qualified to A1 or equivalent standard.
<b>Verification</b>	The assessment process will be verified by an internal verifier qualified to V1 or equivalent standard.
<b>Certification</b>	The programme is certificated by Logic Certification Ltd – A Certification Body accredited by UKAS as compliant with the requirements of BS EN ISO 17024.
