Title	WRAS - Water Regulations
Duration	Initial 1 day Renewal 1 day
Aims and Objectives	A training and assessment programme designed to give plumbers and heating installers a working knowledge of the Water Regulations (1999).
Scope	This Water Regulations course is a pre-requisite for those wishing to join any of the following schemes: Water Industry Approved Plumber Scheme (WIAPS), Competent Persons Scheme (CPS) or Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS).
Pre-Requisites	Candidates should possess a working knowledge of plumbing and heating systems.
Training	<p>The training programme will utilise various Standards and Regulations and encompass the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Water Regulations (1999)• DEFRA Guidance documents for water supply• Suitable materials and substances• Requirements for water fittings• System design• Commissioning• Prevention of cross contamination• Backflow prevention• Hot water services• WC's and flushing devices• Sanitary appliances and water for outside use
Competence	The candidate's knowledge and understanding of the subject will be established by the application of a multi-choice theoretical question papers.
Assessment	The assessment will be conducted by an assessor qualified to A1 or equivalent standard.
Verification	The assessment process will be verified by an internal verifier qualified to V1 or equivalent standard.
Certification	The programme will be certificated by Logic Certification Ltd – A Certification Body accredited by UKAS as compliant with the requirements of BS EN ISO 17024.
